Our Parish volunteers every Wednesday from December to March, depending on weather condition. No Experience Needed!

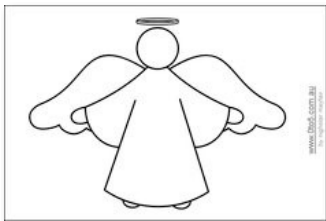
